GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

- The candidates must ensure that the particulars such as enrolment number, examination centre code, programme code as mentioned below and month and year on side 'A' of the OMR sheet have been filled up correctly and also their corresponding circles have been darkened in respective column:
 - **555 for OPENMAT**
 - **666 for B.Ed**
 - **888 for OPENNET**

The Programme particulars and candidate's particulars on side 'B' of the OMR sheet have been correctly mentioned.

- Candidates are required to use Blue/Black Ball point pen only for marking answer responses by darkening the circle and mentioning corresponding digit in the rectangle against the serial number of the question in the OMR Sheet.
- The candidates must follow the instructions given by the Centre Superintendent and the Invigilator at the examination venue.
- **USE OF CALCULATOR, CELL PHONES, BOOKS, SLIDE-RULES, NOTE-BOOKS OR WRITTEN NOTES, ETC. IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE EXAMINATION HALL.**
- Any candidate found indulged in copying or receiving-giving assistance to other candidates, etc. in the examination will be treated under '**unfair means**' activities and the matter will be decided, as per University Rules.
- The University also reserves the right to cancel the result of the candidates who impersonate or uses/adopts other malpractice.
- The examination is conducted under uniform conditions. The University would also follow a procedure to verify the validity of scores of all candidates uniformly. If there is substantial indication that the performance of any candidate is not genuine, University may cancel the result of such candidate.
- All rough works is to be done on question paper booklet only and not on any other paper, Scrap paper is not permitted. For arriving at answers, the candidate may work in the margins, may mark or underline in the question paper booklet.
- After the Examination, the candidates must return the OMR sheet to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall. However, he/she may take away the question paper booklet with him.
- The hall ticket of the Entrance Test must be retained intact as it will be required to be produced at the time of admission. Admission forms without hall ticket in original will summarily be rejected. In case of loss, duplicate Hall ticket will not be issued.
- Candidates may please ensure that the Hall Ticket is signed by the Invigilator. In the absence of the signature, the candidature will be not be considered for admission even if the candidate has qualified the entrance test.
