

MASTER IN SOCIAL WORK (MSW)

Total number of credits: 72
Medium of Instruction: English and Hindi
Eligibility: Bachelor's degree from a recognized University
Duration: Minimum 2 years and Maximum 4 years; offered in both January & July cycle of admissions
Fees: Rs 36000/- (subject to change as per University norms)

- MSW programme aims to professionally train a student to be a social worker.
- With a 40:60 weightage of fieldwork to theory courses, a student will learn the skills to be a professional social worker.
- It is a fieldwork intensive programme so a student gets to practice what she/he learns in the theory courses.
- The student after completing MSW can be employed in NGOs.
