Detailed Information and Guidelines for National Feature Writing Competition

(Please read the guidelines carefully)

Theme: Relevance of Swami Vivekananda as Youth Icon in Modern Times

Language: Hindi or English

Prizes: 1st Prize (₹ 5,000 & Certificate), 2nd Prize (₹ 3,000 & Certificate), 3rd Prize (₹ 2,000 & Certificate), and Consolation prize (₹ 1,000 & Certificate). **Certificates will also be given to other participants who will submit quality features.**

Word Limit: 1200 to 1500 words

Eligibility: Any student pursuing Diploma or Certificate (after 10+2) / Under-Graduate / PG Diploma / Post-Graduate / M.Phil. / Ph.D. programmes can participate in this competition. Only one feature per participant will be accepted. **Participants must submit a SELF ATTESTED copy of their student Identity Card or any other such evidence along with the feature.** The winners will be asked to show their original photo identity card at the time of receiving of the prizes.

Last Date: 7th January 2022

Submission of Features: Feature can be submitted in two following ways –

i. Soft copy of the feature or properly scanned handwritten feature can be submitted to mjml020@ignou.ac.in (fourth digit of email ID is small L and fifth and seventh digits are numerical zero)

ii. Hard copy of typed or handwritten features can be submitted through speed post or courier to the following address:
